The Agricultural Commissioner promotes and protects agriculture, the environment, and public welfare through enforcement of various laws and regulations. This role encompasses four distinct functions; Agricultural Commissioner, Sealer of Weights and Measures, Animal Care and Control, and staff support for the Fish and Wildlife Commission, while managing a budget of over \$8M and a staff of 66 employees. The ability to develop positive work relationships with the County's wide range of constituents including the agricultural community, the varied interests of the general community, elected officials and the CAO and his staff, is an essential aspect of this position.

The position requires five years experience in the enforcement of agricultural or weights and measures laws and possession of appropriate state licenses for this role. A Bachelor's degree in agriculture, biological or physical sciences is required.
